The Three R's-

• Be Respectful

You will have your necessary classroom materials and your assignments completed on time.

Classroom Management

Acknowledgements:

If students demonstrate the 4th grade expectations they may receive:

Verbal praise
Trojan tickets
Classroom coupons for special privileges
Positive emails or phone calls to parents/guardians

Consequences:

If students fail to demonstrate the 4th grade expectations they may receive:

Verbal warning
Refocus time and conference with teacher
Loss of privilege (recess)
Email or phone call to parents/guardians
Written warning
Conference with the principal
Detention

Absent Work

If a student is absent then that student will have the same number of days to turn in the assignment(s) as the number of days absent. There will be no penalty for the missed assignment(s) unless it is not completed within the allowed time. It is the student's responsibility to complete the missed assignments in the appropriate amount of time. It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian to call and request the materials. Please call the school office at 529-4151 by noon for work to be picked up in the office after 3:30 p.m.

Late Work

If your child has not been absent, but comes to school without work completed, he or she will stay in at recess to finish the assignment(s). If your child leaves work at home, he or she will not be allowed to call a parent or guardian to bring the missing assignment(s).


<u>Folder</u>

Every day students will bring home a fourth grade multi-pocket folder which will contain their assignments, graded work, menu notes, school announcements, and many other important pieces of information. <u>Students must have this folder for class every day.</u>

This folder is an important communication and organizational tool. Your assistance in going through the items in this folder with your child would be greatly appreciated. On the front cover of this folder, there will be a weekly parent sign and return portion. At the end of each week, please sign to acknowledge that you have looked at and taken out the papers in the to parents section of the folder. Signed folders will be due on Mondays (or the start of each school week).

The first day of each week the students will be given two copies of the fourth grade assignment sheet which lists the assignments for the week ahead. Students should keep one copy inside the back cover of the multi-pocket folder and keep the other copy at home to refer to.
