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I hope everyone is healthy and rested. We've had several kids out with the flu and other illnesses. The classroom has been sanitized as much as we can, and we're washing hands regularly. Students are finishing up their Olympic articles, but we'll still be watching some videos while we await the start of the games. Mark your calendars for Friday, February 9th for the opening ceremony. Progress reports come home this Friday. Parent conferences are also coming up, so let me know if you'd like to meet and I'll get the schedule started. Notes will be coming home with progress reports to sign up as well. I'm sorry grades haven't been updated in STI, the site has been having some updates the past week or so.

**Spelling:** Vowels with r is the spelling unit this week. When the letter r is controlling the vowel next to it, it changes the vowels sound. Practice sounding the words out slowly while you spell them to hear the sounds. You can practice them on Spelling City too, it's linked on the 3rd grade website.

**Math:** We're getting to our last chapter on multiplication and division. We'll work with multiplying three numbers at a time this week. Ask your student what it means to decompose a number (break it into easier numbers). Keep practicing your facts at home, and using your strategies!!! There's a lot of fun games to practice multiplication on multiplication.com.

**ELA/Reading:** We started reading <u>The Lemonade War</u> last week and read through chapter 3. This is a fun story about a brother and sister who start a lemonade stand war. I've uploaded the audio files to the chapters we've read if you want to listen to it with you student. Hearing it twice will reinforce the story and let you ask some good questions about what's going on. This book has 13 chapters, so we'll be reading it for a couple of weeks. The reading skills we're focusing on are listed on the weekly schedule.

**Writing:** There's a few students who are finishing their Olympic articles. We'll watch a couple of Olympic sport videos and compare the sports.

**Social Studies/Science:** Students enjoyed creating their habitat 2D posters. They'll be hanging in the hallway on Academic Night, so plan on coming out to see them. We'll write short habitat reports to go along with our posters as well. We'll get started on our economic unit later this week.
