If you have another student in K-2, they're program will be in the morning. Keep practicing those multiplication facts at home

Spelling: Our spelling words this week have the sounds of /j/, /k/, and /s/ this week (not the letters). Ask what letters make these sounds. You can practice them on Spelling City too, it's linked on the 3rd grade website.

Math: We'll continue on with multiplication and division this week. Students will start tracking their own progress on multiplication.com. Charts and instructions will be sent home at the end of the week, if students want to practice at home.

ELA/Reading: Students will be in groups for book clubs this week. Each group will read a chapter book together and complete a skill lesson each day. We'll also write a cause and effect story this week similar to If You Give a Mouse a Cookie. Ask your student what animal they chose.

Writing: Talk about what you're thankful for at home, students will be writing about it this week.

Social Studies/Science: We started talking about kindness last week and will continue this week. We'll also start doing daily random acts of kindness. Ask your student if they've done any RAK's at home.
