Math: We had some fun learning geometry and the names for some of the shapes. We'll start learning measurement this week.

Reading: We'll read Suki's Kimono this week and learn how a little girl handles being treated differently at school.

ELA/Writing: Students will write another poem this week to wrap up Poetry month. We'll also learn about adverbs.

Social Studies/Science: We've learned a lot about weather and will move on with landforms this week. Students will be assigned a landform to research and present to the class.
