Our class had a fabulous first week! We learned some things about each other and had some fun. We wrote our classroom rules and learned some of the routines. All students in my room have a job each week that they're responsible for. Ask your student what their job is this week! Students are enjoying earning their "hot tickets" for good behavior in class and cashing them in for couch time, lunch with a friend, and iPad time. Please remember to wear or bring tennis shoes on PE days. We'll be getting our netbooks this week and learning how to use them. Make sure you've send the netbook approval form back signed.

Webpage: I try to keep my classroom webpage, as well as the 3rd grade webpage updated as frequently as possible. You will find newsletters/assignment sheets uploaded to the webpage, as well as information and links to useful sites that we use at school.

Spelling: In 3rd grade we do a new list of spelling words each week, with tests being on Friday. Normally there are fifteen basic words and five bonus words. The new list will be sent home each Friday, as well as Monday on the assignment sheet. They can also be found on SpellingCity under my name. The students will learn how to get to this as well. Spelling words should be practiced at home. Spelling homework will be sent home at the beginning of the week and is due that Friday.

Math: We will do our beginning of the year math assessments this week to see what students know. Friday we'll start our place value chapter with a fun activity.

Reading: We'll start our first story this week!! We will read When Charlie McButton Lost Power about what a little boy does when his power goes out. Ask your student what they would do if the power was out.

Writing: We will go over what a good 3rd grade sentence is and discuss sentences versus fragments. Students will practice writing good 3rd grade sentences with vocabulary words.

Social Studies/Science: We will continue with Science this week, discussing what students saw during the eclipse. Our first unit will start with the Earth and phases of the Moon.
