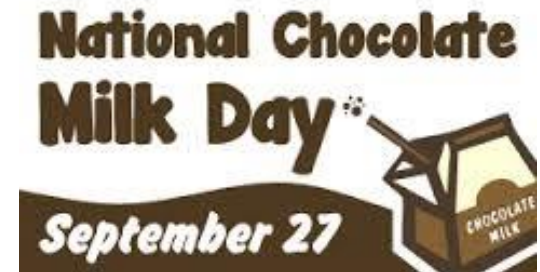

Social Studies/Science: Students will learn more about how gravity works in space. We'll learn about the International Space Station and how the astronauts survive there.


