Reading: We'll be working on sequencing this week. We'll read a fun story and get ready for our story "Kumak's Fish". Practice sequencing things at home, even your daily routine, or how to make a PB & J sandwich!

Writing: Students will begin learning the different types of sentences. This week we'll focus on declarative and interrogative. Ask them which is which.

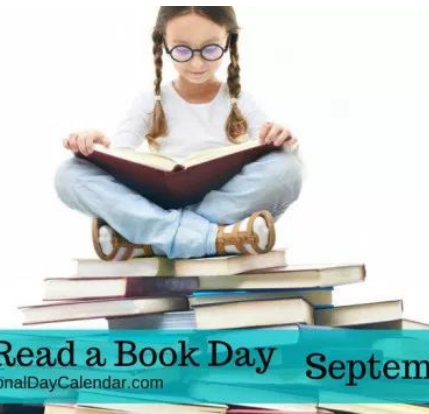
Social Studies/Science: We enjoyed learning all about how the Earth moves around the Sun. We'll compare the moon and planets this week and talk a little more about space.
