W1A - Literature 1.5 (almost 2.0) - Samantha Hunt

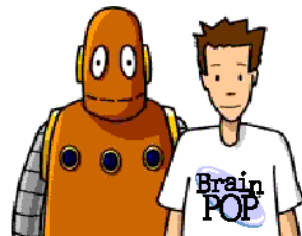
